**CAPSULES** Offering a wide variety of capsule sizes, customized compound medications, and strengths. For those pets on multiple medications we can customize each order in different colored capsules.



**TABLETS** Micro tablets are compressed and quick dissolving, making them an immediate favorite for many pet owners. They are very small, easy to administer, and available for most medications.



**OTIC GELS** Otic ear packs are the perfect resolution for animals with chronic ear infections. This lanolin base product typically contains three different medications: anti-fungal, steroid, and antibiotic. Veterinarians can add or subtract any medication to their liking, making a truly customizable product. It is typically a one-time medication that is applied in house that lasts for 10-14 days. Owners will no longer have to medicate their pet's ears on a daily basis, increasing the efficacy and compliance with both pet and pet owner.



**SUSPENSIONS** Pharmacists have an acute awareness of drug stability in various forms. In many cases certain species of animals are only capable of taking liquid medications. For this reason, it is paramount that compounded medications are stable in a liquid form. Once this is determined, appropriate medications can be suspended into a liquid, from there we can add flavoring to make the medication more palatable.

Maybe your animal craves a meaty, fishy flavor or prefers something sweet and salty...we offer over 30 flavors to choose from to accommodate a wide variety of species.

Oral suspensions are delivered in amber bottles containing an easy to use cap and an oral syringe to prevent waste and mess. We are confident that our oral suspensions will meet the needs of every pet owner.



**TRANSDERMALS** Transdermal gels are one of the easiest, but least-known pet medication delivery methods. These gels allow medications to be absorbed through the animal's skin, so there's no need to force them to swallow pills. Pharmaceutically compounded transdermal gels make medication much easier on pet patients and their owners, and many of the most common feline medications, including methimazole, prednisolone, and amitriptyline, are available in the transdermal format.




